No-Cost, Hands-On Assistance to Apply for the WaterSMART Aquatic Ecosystem Restoration Program

The Aquatic Ecosystem Restoration Program (AERP) funds the study, design, and construction of aquatic ecosystem restoration projects, for the purpose of improving the health of fisheries, wildlife and/or aquatic habitat. A wide variety of activities are eligible under the broad umbrella of Aquatic Ecosystem Restoration.

Eligible Projects Include:

- Study and Design activities which develop an aquatic ecosystem restoration project, resulting in a study and design package which can be used to apply for additional funding
- Construction Projects that are collaboratively developed, have widespread regional benefits, and are for the purpose of improving of the health of fisheries, wildlife, and aquatic habitat through restoration and improved fish passage.

Who's Eligible to Apply?

WaterSMART grants are open to states, Tribes, irrigation districts, water districts, or other organizations with water or power delivery in the Western US. Nonprofit conservation organizations acting in partnership with one of the above eligible organizations are also eligible to apply.

Federal Funding Amount:

- Between \$500,000 and \$2M for Study and Design Projects, or between \$3M and \$20M for Construction Projects.
- Applicants must be able to supply at least 35% of total project cost as non-Federal cost share.
