The Communications & Social Media Engagement Associate will work closely with team members to:

- Support Salesforce database management and organization to maximize efficiency in staying connected with a constantly evolving member base;
- Develop & implement plans to engage LinkedIn connections and establish a presence on Instagram or similar platform; and
- Help with social media and website content creation including short articles, graphics, snapshots into the organization, fun posts, and spotlighting of partner organizations.

A strong candidate will possess the following attributes:

- Commitment to sustainable water policy;
- Excellent writing and research skills;
- Organized with good attention to detail;
- High degree of professionalism and reliability;
- Experience with or interest in local government;
- Experience with database management and organization; and
- Experience with social media platforms and content creation.

Qualifications and Requirements:

- Must be at least a sophomore in an undergraduate program;
- Positions are available on a rolling basis;
- We require a minimum time commitment of 8-10 hours per week; and
- Remote candidates welcome.

This is a volunteer position and work stipends are not available. This position may be eligible for course credit, and WaterNow will support applicants' efforts to receive credit.
